

## *PERFORMING ARTS GUILD SCHOLARSHIP*

### *Guidelines:*

Applications are open to anyone interested in studying the arts.

This includes, but is not limited to, performing, directing, teaching drama, music, visual arts, technical craft, comedy, dance, set design, etc.

*Annual Scholarships:*     \$800.00

*College:*     Up to \$500.00 in Scholarship funds will be awarded to a student or divided among several students pursuing the arts.

*General:*     Three Scholarships up to \$100.00 for workshop/class pertaining to the arts.

The Board of Directors shall appoint a Scholarship Committee to consider and review all applications. In its sole discretion, the Scholarship Committee will determine and recommend the distribution of Scholarships.

### *Scholarship Committee:*

Two Board Members

One PAG Member in Good Standing

College Scholarship applications must be received by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026.

Recipients will be notified of award prior to OHS Honors Night.

General Scholarship applications should be submitted at least 6 weeks prior to the workshop or class desired.

*PAG Limits applications to individuals living in Mt Morris and Oregon or attending the Oregon School District #220 or those who may reside out of these boundaries but have had prior affiliation with the Performing Arts Guild.*
